- 1. The Chair welcomed the APPG members to the first session to discuss Covid Passes.

 - Scientific/Public Health implications: Dr Roland Salmon, former Director of the Communicable
 Disease Surveillance Centre (Wales) & Dr David Bell, Public Health Physician, formerly
 working on infectious diseases for the World Health Organization (WHO)
 - Economic implications: Professor David Paton, Professor of Industrial Economics, Nottingham University Business School
 - Civil liberties and ethical implications: Madeleine Stone, Legal and Policy Officer, Big Brother Watch
- 3. All four experts argued against Covid Passes.
- 4. The Chair invited Members to ask questions. Members were able to probe the experts further on particular points of concern following each examination of the evidence. A summary of the discussion can be found here.
